Its objectives as set out in its constitution, is the restoration and effective delivery of traditional and natural medicine health care and attainment of the highest level of wholeness especially for impoverished nations.

WONM philosophy is based on fundamental human rights, calling for recognition from both individuals and governments to recognize the right of natural and traditional healthcare as a viable choice for the poor. It seeks to fulfill its mandate for Humanitarian service by establishing “CLINICS FOR HUMANITY” to deliver free Natural and traditional healthcare geared towards the poor. In addition to it humanitarian clinics WONM also offers education through its University of Humanitarian Medicine. It is working on developing a team of ambassadors representing nations, with established missions and registered offices.

## **CREDENTIALING**

WONM is not a practitioner based credentialing organization and does not provide credentials to any individuals or groups. Its registry department maintains a data base of qualified doctors and practitioners who have met its criteria for humanitarian service personnel, to participate in its Clinics for Humanity projects and or to dispatch as needed to administer to the needs of poor in the areas of poverty relief, education, health care and community development.

**Note: The Doctor of Missionary Medicine (DMM), Doctor of Humanitarian Service (DHS), and Practitioner of Humanitarian Service (PHS) designations are exclusive to WONM and clearly identify our mission for humanitarian and missionary medicine delivery.**

## **CLINICS FOR HUMANITY™**

The mission of WONM is to fulfill the duty entrusted to it by its first meeting of its founders, the delivery of primary health care and natural medicine to the worlds economically deprived peoples. The human cost of conflicts is immense, and the physical and psychological wounds they inflict on the population are enormous. This reinforces the necessity of developing a worldwide group, geared towards education, traditional natural medicine health care delivery and peace. Hopefully, this will awaken within societies, the values, attitudes and bonds of common interest necessary to transcend the differences arising from conflicts and inequities.

Governments are restricted in providing cost effective primary health care to the poor, due to their reliance on manufactured drugs. Most doctors are at a loss without expensive hospital technology, technicians and prescription drugs. Their lack of knowledge with respect to traditional natural medicine prevents them from using an inexpensive, effective and reliable source of healthcare.

WONM's members; are required to participate in its humanitarian projects by such as; helping to establish Clinics for Humanity, education, through WONM University international satellites, for and to help in community development, geared towards the poor whenever it is needed.

WONM Clinics for Humanity projects are finance by it member's donations and also accepts funding from non members, government and non-governmental organization without conditions attached. Member's obligation donation is required on an annual basis to support its mission.

## **WONM FOUNDATION CANADA**

WONM Canada Clinics for Humanity project was established in October 2006 by, Hon. Dr Sheila McKenzie, Deputy Minister for Politics of Protection of Family and International Community under the International Parliament for Safety and Peace (IPSP), and Dame of Merit Sovereign Orthodox Order of Knights Hospitaller (DSJ).

## **WONM-UHM FELLOWSHIP**
